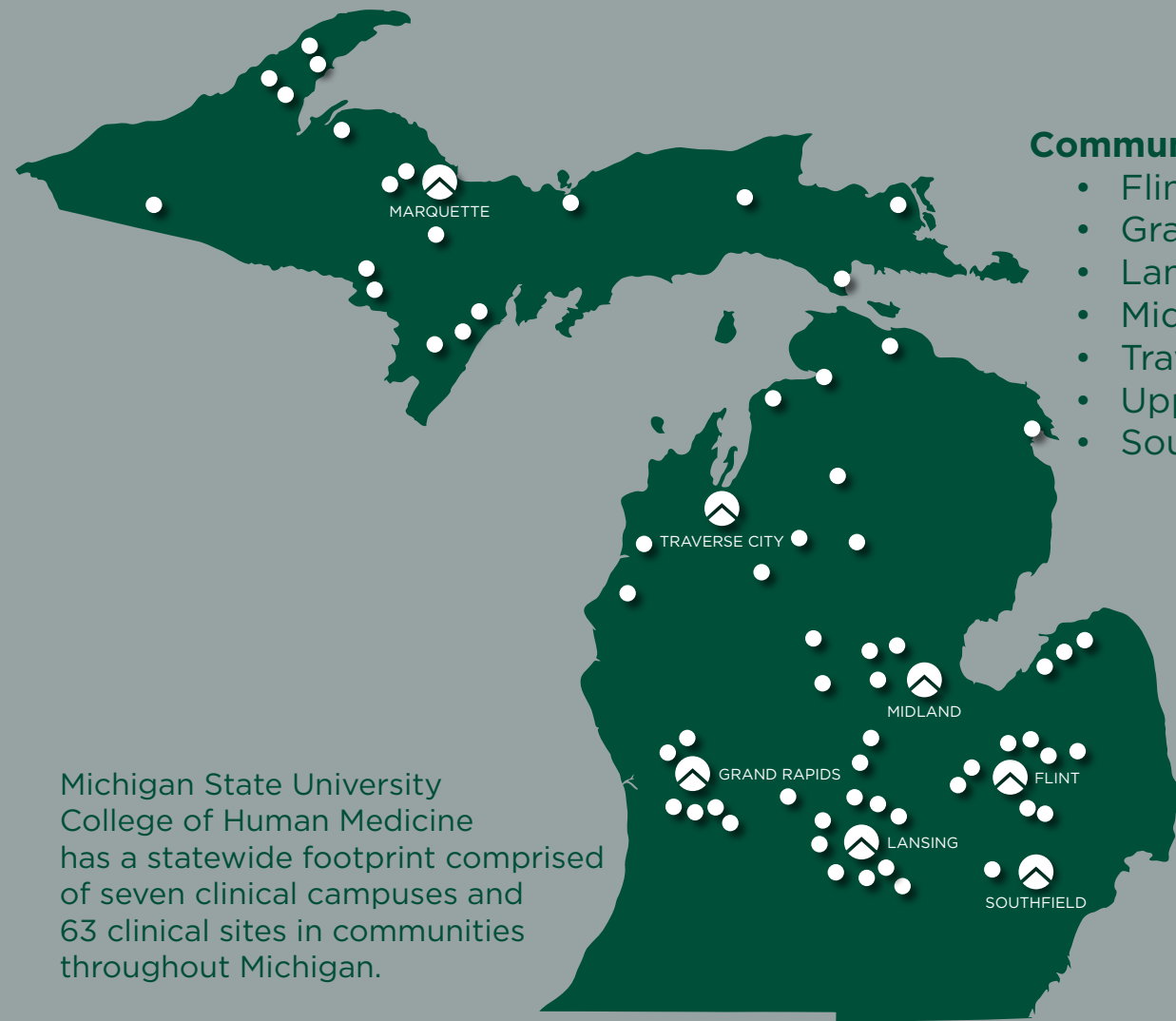


The Extraordinary Impact of Endowed Gifts

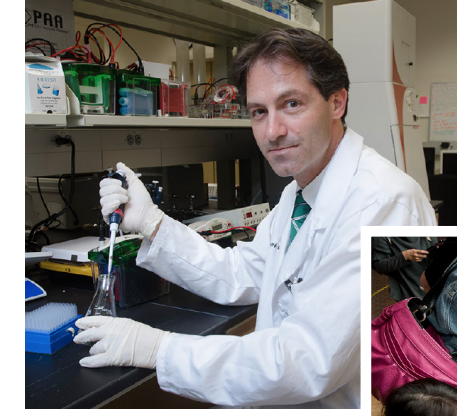
